

Symons Recreation Complex Natatorium Board Minutes February 8, 2021

The Natatorium Board met virtually via Webex on February 8, 2021 at 7:00 pm. The following people were in attendance: Marty Brewer, Chad Cosgrove, Tim Gottschall, John Cler and John Collins. Administrator Langreck and Tracy Gobin was also present.

1. Call to Order- Tim Gottschall called the meeting to order at 7:03pm. Roll call was called, board members in attendance: Tim Gottschall, John Cler, John Collins, Chad Cosgrove, Marty Brewer.
2. Proof of Notification- Proof of Notification was met, per Gobin.
3. Approve Agenda- *Chad Cosgrove made a motion to approve the agenda. John Cler seconded. The motion carried.*
4. Approve Minutes – *Gottschall approved the minutes from the January 11th, 2021 meeting. The motion carried.*
5. Approve Bills for February – Invoices were presented in the amount of \$1,622.89. *John Cler made a motion to pay the monthly bills. Chad Cosgrove seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
6. Budget Overview - Gobin stated there was a surge of people coming back in late January. Memberships are increasing with the new year compared to December 2020. Attendance is increasing as well compared to the previous month. Memberships and attendance are still not what they were prior to COVID, but we are on the right track at increasing memberships and attendance. Gobin stated she is looking forward to seeing the February numbers as the first part of February seems to be busier than January.
7. Director's Position- Administrator Langreck presented two documents: a timeline for the hiring of the director's position and the current job description for the Director's position. *John Collins made a motion to proceed with the hiring of a full time Director for Symons Recreation Complex following the proposed timeline. John Cler seconded. The motion carried. Marty Brewer made a motion to approve the job description of the Director's position at Symons Recreation Complex. John Cler seconded. The motion carried.*
8. Interim Director's report – Gobin stated Symons is hosting the Symons Triathlon challenge again this year. During the month of February participants have a month to complete the mileage of a Triathlon. Last year 42 people participated and this year there are 48 people registered. Log rolling is proceeding well and able to maintain social distancing protocols. Symons is partnering with UWP-Richland Seasonal Activities class to use the facility for a couple of weeks due to the cold weather outdoors.
9. Future Agenda Items - Collins would like to have an update from the County Health Department on when Symons is able to increase their numbers in the facility
